Profit on difference in currency exchange between China's yuan and US dollar is \$3,896.92 The exchange rate profit was determined by using Quicken to adjust the rate artificially for the balance of accounts report at 6.12 for August first 2012 and 6.098 for August first 2012. This showed how much overall the change in rate of currency exchange made in our Yuan accounts in China. The exchange rates were taken from the internet. Form 990-EZ, Part I, Line 10 - Blessing Hands gives school aid, high school tuitions and college scholarships in three Chinese provinces: Guangxi, Yunnan, and Guizhou. We have helped over a 58 students with university scholarships within China this year. Over 267 students have gone through our programs in Yangshuo, Du'an, An Long, Kunming, Shangri-la and Qinzhou this year. This year we have installed 7 water purifiers in primary schools in Yangshuo, and An Long Counties in the Guangxi and Guizhou Provinces of China. We have provided library books to one primary school this year. We have supported 10 village health assistants in Du'an County. Form 990-EZ, Part I, Line 16 - Investment management fees \$22, Advertising and Promotion \$82.15, Office expenses \$10.25, Information Technology \$532.06, Travel \$333.19, hotels \$142.65, non PR Taxes \$8.87, Financial expense for online fundraising 305.76, phone 81.25, bank fees \$440.83, Volunteer expenses \$286.93, and Professional membership \$47 Form 990-EZ, Part I, Line 20 - Money for medical treatment of Wei Senbao reserved for future use is \$3,724. Last year's balance was off by \$264 since we neglected to add in petty cash and cash left from the China cash account. \$7,888 in funds expected to be spent on new program in Kunming for minority families.
